| Monday night | B Ladder Trophy | Donated by Mrs IT Brown. First awarded in 1974 |
| | The Holmes Trophy | Donated by Dr Mike & Mrs Brenda Holmes. For runner-up in the B ladder. First awarded in 2015 |
| | C Ladder Trophy | Donated by Mrs Iris Taylor. For non Senior Reserve players. First awarded in 1998 |
| | Flaxmere Trophy | Donated by Mr WF Mulligan – originally named Flaxmere Rosebowl. First awarded in 1971 |
| | King Trophy | Donated by Mrs Joy King. Played in conjunction with the Flaxmere trophy. Senior Reserve players are not eligible. First awarded in 1976 |
| | J.A. Irwin Trophy | Donated by Mr John Irwin. B and C pairs playing together are not eligible. First awarded in 1991 |
| | Individual Trophy | Donor is unknown First awarded in 1966 |
| | Walker Trophy | Donated by Allan & Hilda Walker. Played in conjunction with the Individual trophy. Rounds played with Senior Reserve players do not count. First awarded in 1997 |
| | Carr Trophy | Donated by the Carr family in memory of Graham Carr. For the best player out of lessons. First awarded in 2013 |
| | King Trophy Novice Plate | Purchased by the club for the top novice pair in the King Trophy. Now for the best player one year out from lessons. First awarded in 1994 |

| Thursday night | Eileen Willoughby Trophy | Donated by Mr JM Willoughby in memory of Eileen Willoughby. After three qualifying nights the field is split into top half and bottom half, who each play a separate competition. First awarded in 1972 |
| | Eileen Willoughby Memorial Plate | Presented by Mrs EW Knight. The winners of the bottom half competition of the last three rounds of the Eileen Willoughby competition. First awarded in 1972 |
| | Handicap Trophy | Donated by Mrs EW Knight. First awarded in 1980 – ceased after 1991. |
| | Kops Trophy | There are two trophies. In 1992 one was presented to the Ashburton Bridge Club by Elly and Aad Kops, The Hague of Holland. Mrs Kops is a sister Martin de Jong, a member of the Ashburton Bridge Club. The other was presented by their club in The Hague, the Schravenhege Bridge School. First awarded in 1992, for the Opening night. In 2005 the Trophy became a two round event, combining the Closing night, and the following year's Opening night. |
| | Mary Mulligan Memorial Trophy | Donated by Mr WF Mulligan in memory of Mary Mulligan. A ladder partners are not eligible. First awarded in 1974 |
| | Mary Mulligan Plate | Purchased by the Club. Called the Mary Mulligan Trophy Intermediate Section. A pair containing a Senior player is not eligible. First awarded in 1991 |
| | President's Trophy | Presented by Mr IP Shearer. A ladders pairs and pairs that played in the Mary Mulligan competition ate not eligible. First awarded in 1969 |
| | Past President's Trophy | Donated by Mrs WF Mulligan. Played in conjunction with the President's trophy. For the best pair who are not both Senior players. First awarded in 1973 |

| | Hazelmere Trophy | Donor is unknown. Different partner each round. First awarded in 1977 |
| | Robinson Salver | Donated by Mr AC Robinson First awarded in 1962 |
| | Ron Sutherland Trophy | Purchased by the club, in memory of Mr Ron Sutherland. First awarded in 1988 |
